DISC GOLF RULES:

General: Disc Golf is played like ball golf with the exception that players throw a flying disc. One stroke is counted each time the disc is thrown or when a penalty is incurred. The object is to get the disc into the basket in the fewest number of strokes possible.

Tee Throws: Tee throws must be completed from the designated tee box. Do not throw until other players or park users are out of range of your throw.

Lie: The spot where the previous throw landed. This is where you make your next throw.

Throwing Order: After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole throws first. The player with the least amount of strokes on the previous hole tees off first on the next hole.

Fairway Throws: Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on spot where the disc lies. The other foot may not be closer to the hole than the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through is allowed outside of a 10-meter (approx. 33') radius from the basket.

Putt: Within a 10 meter (approx. 33') radius of a basket, a player may not step past the lie when attempting to putt.

Completion of Hole: A disc that comes to rest in the basket or chains constitutes successful completion of the hole. A disc coming to rest on the top of the target does not count as a completed hole.

Elevated Lie: Any disc that comes to rest above ground level (in a tree, etc.) may be played at ground level directly beneath the originally-thrown disc. No penalty stroke is added.

Optional Re-throw: If a player cannot play from a lie, a rethrow may be taken with a one stroke penalty.

Out of bounds: Any disc landing in a road or parking lot, a pavilion or playground, in lakewater or across any property line and other areas marked as such on tee signs, is considered OUT OF BOUNDS. Player throws from point where disc went OB with 1-stroke penalty.

Mandatories: When a tee sign indicates a mandatory (mando), a player's disc must pass by the mandatory point on the side indicated by the arrow. Discs flying outside of the mando point garner a 1-stroke penalty and a re-throw from the previous lie.

Course Courtesy: Course users shall let safety be their first concern. Please do not throw if another park user is within range. Help new players learn the course and rules and most importantly HAVE FUN!

Trash: Please use Recycling bins and place trash in trash cans. Please help keep the park clean.
