

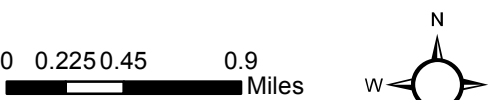
Know Before You Go

- Fill out a **Blueway Trail Permit** at kiosk. Permit should be filled out entirely with complete route plan. White Copy – Paddler, Yellow Copy – Visitor Vehicle Dash, Pink Copy – Kiosk Drop Box
- All state park islands and Turkey Creek camping areas require a camping permit. Permits can be obtained through the Tims Ford State Park visitor center. Only one group per island is permitted. Permits are on a first come, first serve basis. Camping is allowed on TVA lands unless otherwise posted. No camping is allowed on TWRA lands. See the map for additional campgrounds.
- Paddle with someone more experienced than you when possible.
- Public display or consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted on public lands.
- TWRA boating, fishing, and hunting rules and regulations apply - www.tn.gov/twra/.
- Obey all local, state, and federal rules and regulations.

Boater Safety Reminders

- Wear a properly fitted U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket at all times while on the water.
- Be visible! Wear bright clothing.
- Never paddle alone. File a trip plan. Notify family or friends of your route and planned time and location of return.
- Check water levels and the weather forecast before departing. Dress appropriately.
- Know how to safely enter, exit, and paddle your canoe or kayak. Know how to get out of, hang on to, and re-enter your capsized boat.
- Do not paddle under the influence of drugs or alcohol, which impair the coordination and balance you need to control a canoe, kayak, raft or SUP.
