Winchester is a leisure and recreational paradise located in the rolling hills of southern middle Tennessee on Tims Ford Lake with 10,700 acres of water and 246 miles of shoreline. Three marinas are available with cabins, boat slips, restaurants, fuel, rentals, boat launch, and bait. Tims Ford State Park offers 400 acres of family fun.
