SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

January 19, 2017

The Winchester City Council met in a special called session on Thursday, January 19, 2017, beginning at 3:30 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was the second reading of Ordinance #990, an ordinance rezoning property on South Jefferson Street from R-2 to C-2; and second reading of Ordinance #991, an ordinance rezoning property on the corner of 4th Avenue SW & Gin Street from R-2 to I-1.
