

MINUTES

August 9, 2016

The Winchester City Council met in regular session at City Hall on Tuesday, August 9, 2016 at 5:00 pm.

Present and participating were: Mayor Terry Harrell presiding; Beth Rhoton, City Administrator; Teena Waggoner, City Recorder; various Department Heads, audience members; news media; and the following Council Members:

Mayor Harrell called the meeting to order with a prayer by Councilman Snead and the Pledge of Allegiance.

In the first item of unfinished business, the minutes of July 12, 2016 were approved on a motion by Councilman Womack and seconded by Councilman Bates. All voted in favor of said motion.

In the first item of business under new business, City Administrator Beth Rhoton presented the bids received for replacing the roof at the Winchester Annex Building located at 123 First Avenue NW. Councilman Spencer made a motion to accept the low bid of \$14,575.00 from Oltman Roofing LLC. Councilman Snead seconded the motion and all members voted in favor of said motion.

In the next item of business, City Administrator Beth Rhoton presented the bids received for the purchase of a wood/brush chipper. Two bids were received, however only one of the bids met the specifications. Councilman Womack made a motion to accept the bid that met specifications from Wilder Motor & Equipment Co, Inc for a Morbark M12R in the amount of \$40,500.00. Councilman Snead seconded the motion and all members voted in favor of said motion.

Under communications Councilwoman Alexander and Councilwoman Bates commented that they really enjoyed the Farm to Table event on Saturday evening. The Mayor stated that he was unable to attend, but has heard several great comments from some of the attendees. Remember that the Downtown stores will be having longer hours and specials on the First Friday of each month.
