SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

SEPTEMBER 29, 2006

The Winchester City Council met in a special session called by Mayor Harrell on Friday, September 29, 2006, beginning at 12:00 noon. The purpose of the special called meeting was Resolution #776, a proposed connector road from the I-24 Connector through Old State Highway 64 to State Highway 50; 2nd reading of Ordinance #865, adopting a code of ethics; and 1st reading of Ordinance #866, rezoning 40 acres of the Anderton property located on the Lynchburg Road from R-1, lowdensity residential district, to R-3A, high-density alternative residential district.

First under unfinished business, the Council approved the second reading of Ordinance #865, adopting the model code of ethics developed by the University of Tennessee Municipal Technical Advisory Service (MTAS) on a motion by Councilman Scharber, seconded by Councilman Glasner, and all voted in favor by the following roll call:

First under new business, the Council approved the first reading of Ordinance #866, rezoning at the request of Larry Phillips, 40 acres of the Anderton property located on the Lynchburg Road from R-1, low-density residential district, to R-3A, high-density alternative residential district. Motion to approve was made by Councilman Womack, seconded by Council Franklin and all voted in favor by the following roll call:

Next, the Council heard the reading of Resolution #776, a resolution for a proposed connector road from the I-24 Connector through Old State Highway 64 (Belvidere Highway) to State Highway 50 (Lynchburg Road). The resolution failed to pass due to lack of a motion.

With no further business to be brought before the Council, the meeting adjourned on a motion by Councilman Scharber, seconded by Councilman Glasner, and all voted in favor of said motion.
