## SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

August 21, 2014

The Winchester City Council met in a special called session on Thursday, August 21, 2014, beginning at 8:00 a.m. The purpose of the special called meeting was the agreements for relocations of United Telephone Utilities (that had been left off of the July 28<sup>th</sup> special called regular Council due to not having this information at that time); Resolution #851 declaring a vacancy on the City Council; and Resolution #852, filling the vacancy on the City Council.

A quorum being present, Mayor Harrell called the meeting to order and the meeting proceeded with the transaction of business. The special called meeting form reads as follows:

In the only order of unfinished business, City

Administrator Beth Rhoton explained that the agreement for relocation of Utilities for United Telephone was not on the special called meeting of July 28, 2014 with the other utility agreements due to not having this information for that meeting. Relocating this utility was part of the TDOT Enhancement Project Grant (Pin #113907) at Porter Street and Dinah Shore Boulevard to complete this project. The original estimated cost for moving the United Telephone utilities in August 2013 was \$5,516.79 and this cost remained the same. Mrs. Rhoton requested approval for payment of \$5,516.79 for relocating this utility that is required to complete the grant project and is reimbursable by TDOT. Motion for approval was made by Councilman Hart, seconded by Councilman Spencer, and all voted in favor of said motion.

First under new business, City Administrator Beth Rhoton presented Resolution #851, a resolution declaring a vacancy on the Winchester City Council as a result of the resignation of Councilman Jack Bell and in keeping with the Winchester City Charter, Article II, Section 2.09(a). Motion for approval was made by Councilman Spencer, seconded by Councilman Womack, and all voted in favor of said motion.

Last under new business, City Administrator Beth Rhoton presented Resolution #852, a resolution appointing Suzanne McDowell to fill the unexpired council term of Jack Bell who resigned on August 13, 2014. Motion for approval was made by Councilman Hart, seconded by Councilman Womack and all voted in favor of said motion.

Mayor Harrell thanked Mrs. McDowell for her willingness to complete Mr. Bell's unexpired term of office and welcomed her back to the City Council. Mrs. McDowell had previously served as a Councilwoman for the City of Winchester for three terms of office. She was first elected in 1991, re-elected in 1995, and again in 1999. More recently, Mrs. McDowell was appointed on May 15, 2013, to fill the unexpired Council term of Cheyne Stewart who had resigned. Mayor Harrell said it's always been a pleasure to work with Mrs. McDowell and she brings a lot of knowledge to the council as well as fresh ideas. Mrs. McDowell stated that she was honored and happy to be appointed to complete Mr. Bell's term of office.

With no further business to be brought before the Council, the meeting adjourned on a motion by Councilman Hart, seconded by Councilman Womack, and all voted in favor of said motion.
